

**NAVY HAZARDOUS MATERIAL IDENTIFICATION
AND MATERIAL SAFETY DATA**

- A. "Hazardous material," as used in this Form, includes the following:
- (1) All items in, or ordinarily cataloged under, the Federal Supply Classes listed in Table I of Appendix A of the latest version of Federal Standard No. 313, including revisions adopted during the term of the contract.
 - (2) Items having hazardous characteristics in the Federal Supply Classes listed in Table II of Appendix A of the latest version of Federal Standard No. 313, including revisions adopted during the term of the contract.
 - (3) Any other item to be delivered under this contract which will contain hazardous material or expose Bettis or Government personnel to those materials.
- B. Attachment A provides Tables I and II of Appendix A of Federal Standard No. 313. Attachment A is current as of December 1989 and is provided solely for information. To obtain the most current listing of purposes of accurate certification, the Offeror shall contact General Services Administration (GSA), Specification Section Room 6654, 7th & D St., S.W., Washington, D.C. 20407, 202-472-2205. The Offeror should provide the certifications found in Attachment B with its bid. If the Offeror certifies that the material to be delivered is a hazardous material, then a Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) meeting the requirements of 29 CFR 1910.1200(g) and the latest version of Federal Standard No. 313 in effect on the date of this solicitation should be submitted with the bid for all hazardous material(s) described in paragraph A. above, unless the Offeror certifies that the material is not hazardous. Data shall be submitted on all items included in the offer, whether or not the Offeror is the actual manufacturer of these items. Failure to provide the certification and MSDS, if applicable, shall be cause for the Offeror to be considered nonresponsible and ineligible for award.
- C. If there is a change in the composition of the item(s) after award or a revision to Federal Standard No. 313 which renders incomplete or inaccurate the data submitted under paragraph B. of this Form or the certification provided, the Seller shall promptly notify the Buyer and resubmit the data.
- D. Neither the requirements of this Form nor any act or failure to act by Bettis shall relieve the Seller of any responsibility or liability for the safety of Bettis, Government, or subcontractor personnel or property.
- E. Notwithstanding any other clause in this inquiry or resulting purchase order, Bettis' rights in data furnished hereunder with respect to hazardous material are as follows:
- (1) To use, duplicate, and disclose any data to which this clause is applicable. The purposes of this right are to-
 - (i) Apprise personnel of the hazards to which they may be exposed in using, handling, packaging, transporting, or disposing of hazardous materials;
 - (ii) Obtain medical treatment for those affected by the material; and
 - (iii) Have others use, duplicate, and disclose the data for Bettis for these purpose(s).
 - (2) That Bettis is not precluded from using similar or identical data acquired from other sources.
