

**ATTACHMENT FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE RESIDED OR WORKED
OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES
(Use Additional Paper as Necessary)**

When an individual has lived, worked, attended school, or had other activity outside the United States, it frequently takes additional time for the completion of a background investigation. If your activities outside the U.S. can be covered through contact with individuals currently in the U.S., your investigation and case adjudication can be completed more quickly than if investigation outside the U.S. is necessary. In the event that foreign investigation is still needed, the additional information you provide can help to expedite your investigation.
